"HEY JUDE!"

When the song, "Hey Jude" became very popular, there was a lot of speculation concerning who Paul McCartney was actually writing about; John Lennon thought Paul was writing about him and his recent separation from his wife, some thought it was about Paul's failing relationship with his longtime girlfriend, and a tabloid journalist in Britain thought it was about her. It was not until 20 years later that Jules Lennon, the son of John Lennon, learned that it was written for him to comfort him during the divorce of his parents. As a matter-of-fact, McCartney originally entitled the song, "Hey Jules." I am not sure why it took so long to let young Lennon know that the words of comfort were for him, but then again, not everything from the Beatles makes sense.

When Jude, the brother of James, wrote his short letter (in the original Greek, 461 words, making it the fifth shortest book in the bible) it was very clear who the audience was. He wrote, "Jude, a bond-servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, To those who are

are the called, beloved in God the Father, and kept for Jesus Christ" (Jude 1:1, NASB). So, Jude was written to the "called," the "beloved" in God

our Father and for those "kept for Jesus Christ." These three things statements highlight some interesting facts about, not only the recipients of the letter, but you and me.

In reading various web content about the Bible and various other subjects, I think the concept of

being "called" has been misunderstood. Paul wrote that we have been "called" by the gospel (2 Thessalonians 2:14). But in the context of Jude, the word "called" means "invited." If you compare the concept of being "invited" to the parable of the wedding feast in Matthew 22:1-14, I believe it becomes clear what Jude meant, especially when Jesus says in Matthew 22:14 that "Many are called [invited] but few are chosen" (v.14).

We know that those to whom Jude wrote were in a relationship with God because Jude speaks to them as "beloved of God." When someone is "beloved", the idea is that our Heavenly Father is pleased with and fond of that individual; in this case the recipients of Jude's letter. Jude, towards the end of his letter said that we need to "keep yourselves in the love of God" (v.21). This "love" is not the general love that God has for all people but rather the love He has for those that keep His

commandments: "Whoever believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God, and whoever loves the Father loves the child born of Him. 2 By this we know that we love the children of God, when we

love God and observe His commandments. 3 For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments; and His commandments are not burdensome" (1 John 5:2-3).

The idea of being "kept for Jesus" could also be translated as "being guarded by Jesus."

The American military has a term that describes this concept extremely well. They call it "overwatch." Coined in the 1950's, Overwatch is a force protection tactic in modern warfare where one small military unit, vehicle, or aircraft supports another friendly unit against an enemy. When the ground units have taken the high ground, they are able to call in naval and air bombardments and alert mission commanders as to the location of enemy positions and enemy troop movement.

So, Jude addresses this letter to those who have responded to the invitation, to those that love God and are loved by Him and are guarded under the overwatch of Jesus Christ. The fact of these three things should definitely give us comfort and make things better in the midst of all the chaos around us. The question remains, of course, have YOU responded to the invitation?

JUDE — A BRIEF SUMMARY

A Brief Summary: According to verse 3, Jude was anxious to write about our salvation; however, he changed topics to address contending for the faith. This faith embodies the complete body of Christian doctrine taught by Christ, later passed on to the apostles. After Jude warns of false teachers (verses 4-16), he advises us on how we can succeed in spiritual warfare (verses 20-21). Here is wisdom we would do well to accept and adhere to as we go through these days of the end times.

Purpose of Writing: The Book of Jude is an important book for us today because it is written for the end times, for the end of the church age. The church age began at the Day of Pentecost. Jude is the only book given entirely to the great apostasy. Jude writes that evil works are the evidence of apostasy. He admonishes us to contend for the faith, for there are tares among the wheat. False prophets are in the church and the saints are in danger. Jude is a small but important book worthy of study, written for the Christian of today.

Practical Application: We live in a unique time in history and this little book can help equip us for the untold challenges of living in the end times. Today's Christian must be on guard for false doctrines which can so easily deceive us if we are not well-versed in the Word. We need to know the Gospel—to protect and defend it—and accept the Lordship of Christ, which is evidenced by a life-change. Authentic faith always reflects Christ-like behavior. Our life in Christ should reflect our very own heart-knowledge that rests on the authority of the Almighty Creator and Father who puts faith into practice. We need that personal relationship with Him; only then will we know His voice so well that we will follow no other. 🗷

SCRIPTURE VERSES FROM JUDE

- ³ Beloved, while I was very diligent to write to you concerning our common salvation, I found it necessary to write to you exhorting you to contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints.
- ⁴ For certain men have crept in unnoticed, who long ago were marked out for this condemnation, ungodly men, who turn the grace of our God into lewdness and deny the only Lord God and our Lord Jesus Christ.
- ⁵ But I want to remind you, though you once knew this, that the Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed those who did not believe. ⁶ And the angels who did not keep their proper domain, but left their own abode, He has reserved in everlasting chains under darkness for the judgment of the great day; ⁷ as Sodom and Gomorrah, and the cities around them in a similar manner to these, having given themselves over to sexual immorality and gone after strange flesh, are set forth as an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.
- ¹⁴ Now Enoch, the seventh from Adam, prophesied about these men also, saying, "Behold, the Lord comes with ten thousands of His saints, ¹⁵ to execute judgment on all, to convict all who are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have committed in an ungodly way, and of all the harsh things which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him."
- ²⁰ But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit, ²¹ keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life. ²² And on some have compassion, making a distinction; ²³ but others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire, hating even the garment defiled by the flesh.
