PSALM 98 (PART TWO)

Synopsis from Part One: As stated last week, Psalm 98 is a beautiful song of praise and points our attention to our victorious God where He is our deliverer (vv. 1-3), our King (vv. 4-6), and our righteous Judge (vv. 7-9). Scholars believe that this Psalm can be thought of as noble and spirit-stirring, one that may have originally been written for some great national triumph of its time.`

There is much mentioned to praise God for throughout this Psalm, but one attribute worth thinking on today is that our God is a God who does not forget (v. 3). That's hard to imagine, because we forget - a lot - and even more so as we as we age! We forget about appointments, commitments, where we put things. But God doesn't forget. He doesn't forget the promises He made to us. He doesn't forget to keep His word. He doesn't forget about us or neglect us. Not even the sparrows are forgotten in His eyes (Luke 12:6).

But brethren, when we see all that is happening in the world, how are we to have joy? When we consider our own personal struggles in life, how can we find joy and hope? During difficult time, the psalms are, of course, always a great place to turn to find strength and words of hope. Many of the psalms were written during personal distresses experienced by God's people. Some of the psalms were written after the nation of Judah was invaded, captured, and carried away into captivity at the hands of foreigners. The psalms are God's book of hope to His people.

Just look at how often the psalm calls for joy and singing. Verse 1 reads, "Sing to the Lord."

Verse 4 reads, "Make a joyful noise, sing praises, break forth into joyous song." Verses 5-6 repeat these calls for joyous songs and joyful noises. Verse 8 says to clap the hands and sing for joy together. The point of this psalm is for God's people to sing and have joy. So, how is this possible?

First, we must realize that our God is a sovereign Savior (vv. 1-3). The new song His people are to sing is a song of salvation offered to the Lord in the context of military victory. For us, we look at God's deliverance from our sins when we see the cross. Our hope in difficult times is the knowledge of God's deliverance — a deliverance that He has revealed to the earth through the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus the Christ.

Continuing: Verses 4-6 are a call for all the earth to make joyful noises and sing praises to the King, the Lord Who is Sovereign King of all. Notice again that our worship is to be joyful. Our worship is not to come from a feeling of obligation but from the joy in our heart that the Lord is king — our God reigns!

This picture of God as king over all the earth is the second reason we can have joy in the midst of distress and fear. God rules over the cosmos — He rules over the earth — He rules. Daniel 2:20-22 (ESV) talks to this point: ²⁰ Daniel answered and said: "Blessed be the name of God forever and ever, to whom belong wisdom and might. ²²



He changes times and seasons; he removes kings and sets up kings; he gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to those who have understanding; ²² he reveals deep and hidden things; he knows what is in the darkness, and the light dwells with [continued on page 6]

him, And in Daniel 4:28-32, as King Nebuchadnezzar is bragging of his great power, he is struck dumb by the Lord of all and became as the beasts of the field. Daniel concludes that this will be an ongoing curse until, "seven periods of time shall pass over you, *until you know that the Most High rules the kingdom of men and gives it to whom he will*" (v. 32 — emphasis mine).

Further, consider the title that is on the thigh of Jesus in the book of Revelation: "On his robe and on his thigh he has a name written, 'King of kings and Lord of lords'" (Revelation 19:16 ESV). Since Jesus is the King over all other kings and the Lord over all other masters, then our joy rests in the knowledge of God's sovereign rule over the events of the earth. This was the message of the book of Revelation — you can have joy and comfort in the knowledge that Jesus is King and Jesus rules over the earth.

In the final verses of Psalm 98 (vv. 7-9) the Psalmist points to God as Sovereign Judge. All of the earth is called upon to rejoice in the Lord. We have already seen that our joy comes from our God as our savior and our God as our king. But we also see in these concluding verses that we can even have joy in distress because God is the judge. Notice this particularly in verses 8-9. "Let the hills sing for joy together before the Lord, for he comes to judge the earth. He will judge the world with righteousness, and the peoples with equity."

The judgment of the Lord is a great occasion for joy! There is statement I've semi-often heard amongst God's people when speaking of His return: "Come Lord Jesus (Just not today!). That my brethren is a sad indictment of the saints of God, our Father." But Jesus will judge the world and we are to sing of the coming judgment day. We are to look forward to the return of Christ. Jesus will make things right. So, in this we can find joy and hope in the judgment of the Lord. There are several New Testament expressions of this truth — 1 Thessalonians 2:13-16 and 2 Thessalonians 1:5-12 are just two.

were killed for their love of the Lord, but God judged those evildoers. It appears we have entered yet another time of global distress but we know that God will judge every evil act committed by every evil person. Our joy is in the return of our Lord.

My brothers and sisters, let us all try to the very best of our ability (and perhaps even further) to remember that our joy and hope come, not from ourselves, but from the Lord who saves, rules, and judges the earth. We do not have to be disturbed by life problems or political issues or global events because God reigns and in the end, he *will* put all his enemies under his feet (1 Corinthians 15:24-26)!

3-8 – ³ Trust in the Lord, and do good; dwell in the land, and feed on His faithfulness. ⁴ Delight yourself also in the Lord, and He shall give you the desires of your heart. ⁵ Commit your way to the Lord, trust also in Him, and He shall bring it to pass. ⁶ He shall bring forth your righteousness as the light, and your justice as the noonday. ⁷ Rest in the Lord, and wait patiently for Him; do not fret because of him who prospers in his way, because of the man who brings wicked schemes to pass. ⁸ Cease from anger, and forsake wrath; do not fret – it only causes harm.

27-33 — ²⁷ Depart from evil, and do good; and dwell forevermore. ²⁸ For the Lord loves justice, and does not forsake His saints; they are preserved forever, but the descendants of the wicked shall be cut off. ²⁹ The righteous shall inherit the land, and dwell in it forever. ³⁰ The mouth of the righteous speaks wisdom, and his tongue talks of justice. ³¹ The law of his God is in his heart; none of his steps shall slide. ³² The wicked watches the righteous, and seeks to slay him. ³³ The Lord will not leave him in his hand, nor condemn him when he is judged.
