ELEVEN REASONS TO MEMORIZE SCRIPTURE

How can we train ourselves in God's way if His Word is not continually in our hearts, guiding our daily living and giving us the strength we so (desperately!) need to get through these days? I'm here to encourage all of us (yes, ALL us older folks! And the few younger in our midst!) to memorize Scripture and reap God's bountiful blessings!

Do you struggle memorizing bible verses? I must admit I do – especially if I just read the verse. But by using different creative methods, memorizing doesn't have to be a drudgery – it can actually be fun! What if we were offered \$100.00 for every bible verse we could memorize in the next seven days? Do you think perhaps our attitude toward Scripture memory and our ability to memorize would improve? Of course in reality, any monetary reward would be small compared to the immense and incalculable value of the treasure of God's Word deposited within our mind.

and gems and there is no safer place to put it than in our hearts (Psalm 119:11; Matthew 13:44). And if WE are enthusiastic and eager to learn the Word of God, then our children and grandchildren and grandchildren and grandchildren may just want to follow our example. Think how wonderful it would be to go through a difficult time, a trial or a temptation, and have memorized verses available, at a moments recall, to encourage us in our walk with God or to comfort a friend or relative.

I would like to invite each of you to look into some of the incredible benefits of memorizing. . . And stay tuned for a future bulletin article where I will be sharing some of my favorite Scripture Memory Tools!

So, why memorize? Are there any benefits of knowing the Bible by heart – after all

most people HAVE a bible (if not 2 or 3 or more!) and, often today, most of us even have at least one Bible app on our phones. If that's true, couldn't we just READ the Bible? Well, that's always better than not ever looking at our Bible at all but let's take a look at some of the benefits of memorizing Bible verses.

First, we would be imitating Jesus! Jesus often quoted Scripture showing that he had memorized what was the Bible in the first century — what we call the Old Testament today. He is our example and we should follow Him. In Matthew 4:1-11 He begins His quotes with "It is written." Altogether in the New Testament, He quoted 24 of the 39 books of the Old Testament 180 times! Memorizing Scripture has the effect of making our gaze on Jesus steadier and clearer. If we want

to be like Jesus we will recite Scripture from memory like He did.

Second, memorization is required for our spiritual growth and we should view committing Scripture as a privilege, not a task to be endured. Though at first we may consider out capability to memorize to be defective, just like our muscles, our mind will gain strength by exercise. So, after a time we will delight in being able to treasure up God's Words of truth! Like me, do you need to write things down in order to remem-

ber them? I make lists of things I need to accomplish such as grocery shopping so as not forget important items. This last week, I didn't have my usual list when I went to the grocery store bought everything I thought I needed. The next day I had to return to buy two thirds again what I bought the day before — all

because I didn't have a list the first time! God knows we can't remember everything or keep His commands without being frequently reminded. This is why He told us to renew our minds in Scripture daily. He already wrote down what we need to know! Bible memorization renews and transforms our minds. (Romans 12:2) Do YOU need to be spiritually transformed? I know I do!

Third, we are called to memorize the Word! We're told to let the Word of Christ dwell in us richly, making it an integral part of our life (Deuteronomy 6:4-9; Colossians 3:16). And brethren, this command is not burdensome but life-giving! Several times each day — or maybe in the beginning, at least once a day — any precious golden moments we experience should be consecrated to prayer and the study of the Scriptures if

only so that we may experience spiritual life in our soul. If we would be loyal to the King of Heaven, we should study and commit to memory daily, His Holy Word!

Fourth, it gives us wisdom we ALL desperate*ly need!* The Bible says wisdom is more precious than rubies (Proverbs 8:11) and gold (Proverbs 16:16). Wisdom, however, is only words if not applied to our daily life and words ONLY become wisdom when they are internalized which allows the heart to change. Are we prepared to sacrifice ALL to acquire the wisdom God wants to freely give us if we ask? God is the author and giver of all wisdom (James 1:5; James 3:17). When we study and memorize the Bible we acquire a knowledge of God, Who He is, what He has promised and who WE are in Christ. Luke 2:52 says Jesus grew in wisdom, stature and in favor with God and man. MEMORIZING Scripture gives us the wisdom required to make the best possible decisions each day (Psalm 119:97-100); it equips us to handle the headaches and heartaches of life (Proverbs 3:5-6) and we learn what His will is for our lives (Romans 12:2).

Fifth, there is a remedy for every malady found in the Bible and that remedy is Jesus Christ as found in God's Word. He is the Word made flesh! (John 1:14) Memorizing Scripture is like having a handy first-aid kit with you all the time — we are more ready for any emergency that comes our way! We can be better equipped to meet the needs of our family, teaching and modeling the way of righteousness and discipling our family members in the ways of Christ. The Word of God is "profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: that the man of God may be perfect (complete) thoroughly furnished (equipped) unto all good works" (2 Timothy 3:16).

MARK 3:20-30 (NIV)

²⁰ Then Jesus entered a house, and again a crowd gathered, so that he and his disciples were not even able to eat. ²¹ When his family heard about this, they went to take charge of him, for they said, "He is out of his mind."

²² And the teachers of the law who came down from Jerusalem said, "He is possessed by Beelzebul! By the prince of demons he is driving out demons."

²³ So Jesus called them over to him and began to speak to them in parables: "How can Satan drive out Satan? ²⁴ If a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. ²⁵ If a house is divided against itself, that house cannot stand. ²⁶ And if Satan opposes himself and is divided, he cannot stand; his end has come. ²⁷ In fact, no one can enter a strong man's house without first tying him up. Then he can plunder the strong man's house. ²⁸ Truly I tell you, people can be forgiven all their sins and every slander they utter, ²⁹ but whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit will never be forgiven; they are guilty of an eternal sin."

³⁰ He said this because they were saying, "He has an impure spirit."
