#### ALL THAT IS, WAS; ALL THAT IS, WILL BE AGAIN-PART THREE

Our memory verse two weeks ago was Ecclesiastes 1:1-11 — <sup>1</sup> The words of the Preacher, the son of David, king in Jerusalem. <sup>2</sup> "Vanity of vanities," says the Preacher; "Vanity of vanities, all is vanity." <sup>3</sup> What profit has a man from all his labor in which he toils under the sun? <sup>4</sup> One generation passes away, and another generation comes; but the earth abides forever. <sup>5</sup> The sun also rises, and the sun goes down, and hastens to the place where it arose. <sup>6</sup> The wind goes toward the south, and turns around to the north; the wind whirls about continually, and comes again on its circuit. <sup>7</sup> All the rivers run into the sea, yet the sea is not full; to the place from which the rivers come, there they return again. <sup>8</sup> All things are full of labor; man cannot express it. the eye is not satisfied with seeing, nor the ear filled with hearing. <sup>9</sup> That which has been is what will be, that which is done is what will be done, and there is nothing new under the sun. <sup>10</sup> Is there anything of which it may be said, "See, this is new"? It has already been in ancient times before us. <sup>11</sup> There is no remembrance of former things, nor will there be any remembrance of things that are to come by those who will come after.

We stated that these first eleven verses could be broken into three parts: (1) Life under The Sun Is Frustrating (vv. 2-3); (2) Earth Remains Constant (vv. 4-7); and (3) Man Remains Discontented (vv. 8-11). We now turn our attention to verses eight through eleven.

(3) Man Remains Discontent (8-11) – In the previous verses we see that the circuits of creation only seem to perpetuate our reality. Starting in verse eight, the Preacher makes ap

parent our connection with creation – the reality of mankind not making any sign of progress while creation's ceaseless activity goes on – that is a vivid picture of our existence.

In verse eight, the weariness of life is exemplified by the inability of a man to speak, as well as the dissatisfaction of his eyes to see and ears to hear. There is no rest because we are never content with our circumstances. We are constantly striving, chasing after the wind as he will mention later on. A similar point is made in Proverbs 27:20: "20 Hell [Sheol] and Destruction [Abaddon] are never full; so the eyes of man are never satisfied." Just as the grave and the underworld are never satisfied by the dead bodies they receive, so our eyes are continually seeking to find something new to gaze upon, our ears are constantly seeking for something tickling to hear; we are perpetually discontent.

The Preacher continues with his observations in verses nine and ten by telling us the history repeats itself. We see mankind making the same mistakes their ancestors made generations before. There is even a statement by George Santayana in his 1905 book, "The Life of Reason" which has become a cliché used to describe this condition: "Those who cannot remember the past are condemned to repeat it." Historians are oftentimes incredibly skilled at predicting where a culture is headed by considering what previous generations did. And for many, the future is bleak. When we look at the path our culture is on, few people find reason to rejoice. Rather, they are filled with anxiety and fear. But the Preacher here is saving. "Don't worry! You'll be forgotten just like every other generation that has passed before you!"

Then in verse eleven, the Preacher says that although we strive to leave a legacy for ourselves, future generations (our posterity) are able to wipe from memory all the records - all the traces of that heritage. A legacy is defined several different ways and can be physical or not. It can be one's faith, ethics and core values, it can be monetary, and it can come from one's character, reputation and the life they've led. Legacies often tremendously impact, encourage, and leave pathways for future generations. A legacy can provide guidance and inspiration for family members and those impacted by you, to live lives that may impact those same individuals' faith, homes, communities and businesses. Yet with all that a legacy can be, it can be eradicated within a generation. Authors and artists and all that come under those two categories often leave their life's work for future generations to pick up and read or gaze upon in wonder, but Hey Mario Kart and the multitude of other video games! ... Artificial Intelligence! ... Tik Tok, Instagram, Facebook, and Snapchat! ... Sports of every kind whether amateur or professional along with all the various sports and other activities in which parents and grandparents enroll their precious ones - with no thought to their spiritual being! ... All of this has and will continue to affect the church of Christ in a myriad of ways ... after all, they're all so much more FUN than all that "religion stuff!" In author Neil Postman's book "Amusing Ourselves to Death," he warns of this very thing:

trivia, when cultural life is redefined as a perpetual round of entertainments, when serious public conversation becomes a form of babytalk, when, in short, a people become an audience, and their public business a vaudeville act, then a nation finds itself at risk; culture-death is a clear possibility.

Right about now, I'm sure you're nodding your head thinking. "Amen! That's right. This generation is in chaos. Our nation will soon be in ruins if we're not already there!" We tend to point our wagging fingers at the world outside.

But what about us? What about you? Where does your idle heart find satisfaction? Are you personally discontent? Be honest.

This is really where we should approach our study of the first eleven verses of Ecclesiastes – indeed the entire book – with an honest assessment of our discontentment. Here's why: because until we've done that, we won't realize that we've been made for so much more than a mere life under the sun. God has blessed us with a soul that will never die, well, blessed if we are Christ's, not so much otherwise.

The frustration we experience in this life is universal. And believers aren't immune from worldly pessimism. But the Christian does have a hope that the unbeliever lacks. That hope stems from the cross. Read what Isaiah 53:10 tells us and see for yourselves, "10 Yet it pleased the Lord to bruise [crush] Him; He has put Him to grief. When You make His soul an offering for sin, He shall see His seed, He shall prolong His days, and the pleasure of the Lord shall prosper in His hand."

The grief that our Lord Jesus endured as He was crushed on the cross points to the fulfillment of all the frustration stemming from the result of our sin. Remember the word "toil" from Ecclesiastes 1:3? In the next verse of Isaiah 53 we see that word again, but this time it is translated "labor" (NKJV) or "anguish" (ESV): "11 He shall see the labor of His soul, and be satisfied. By His knowledge My righteous Servant shall justify

many, for He shall bear their iniquities."

Brethren, we have hope, because we have a Savior whose eyes were satisfied by what He saw as the result of His redemptive work. What did He see? His offspring (v.10). That's you and me, and all who believe and obey!

Jesus' cry of despair, "My God, My God, why have you forsaken me?" is the fulfillment of the frustration that all believers face in this life. And, in the midst of suffering that toil, labor, anguish, our Lord saw the fruit of His turmoil, and He was satisfied. On the cross, Jesus bore our life of vaniforniued on page 8

In summary, the quest for life's meaning begins with an honest assessment of our discontentment – let's not sugarcoat this reality. For, fortunately, for all who believe and obey Christ, there is a hope received in our redemption. Because of the resurrection, our toil and hard labor is NOT in vain. 1 Corinthians 15:58 reminds us: "58 Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord."

The resurrection of Jesus Christ has cleared up any ambiguity left by Ecclesiastes regarding the afterlife. The Preacher argued that nothing is remembered (v.11), but He taught: "25 . . . 'I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. <sup>26</sup> And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?'" (John 11:25-26). If not, we will remain discontent as we search in vain for that elusive meaning in life. **\beta**

Most assuredly, I say to you, whatever you ask the Father in My name He will give you. <sup>24</sup> Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full.
