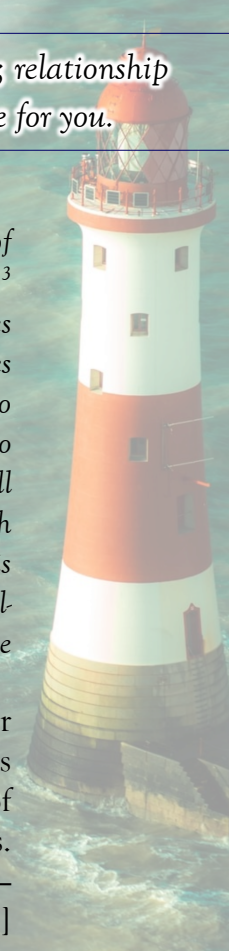

ALL THAT IS, WAS; ALL THAT IS, WILL BE AGAIN – PART TWO

Our memory verse last week was Ecclesiastes 1:1-11 – ¹ The words of the Preacher, the son of David, king in Jerusalem. ² “Vanity of vanities,” says the Preacher; “Vanity of vanities, all is vanity.” ³ What profit has a man from all his labor in which he toils under the sun? ⁴ One generation passes away, and another generation comes; but the earth abides forever. ⁵ The sun also rises, and the sun goes down, and hastens to the place where it arose. ⁶ The wind goes toward the south, and turns around to the north; the wind whirls about continually, and comes again on its circuit. ⁷ All the rivers run into the sea, yet the sea is not full; to the place from which the rivers come, there they return again. ⁸ All things are full of labor; man cannot express it. the eye is not satisfied with seeing, nor the ear filled with hearing. ⁹ That which has been is what will be, that which is done is what will be done, and there is nothing new under the sun. ¹⁰ Is there anything of which it may be said, “See, this is new”? It has already been in ancient times before us. ¹¹ There is no remembrance of former things, nor will there be any remembrance of things that are to come by those who will come after.

We stated that these first eleven verses could be broken into three parts: (1) Life Under The Sun Is Frustrating (vv. 2-3); (2) Earth Remains Constant (vv. 4-7); and (3) Man Remains Discontented (vv. 8-11). Last week we covered verse one which sets the tone for the rest of Ecclesiastes – that no matter what we do or how we do it, it's all vanity; nothing matters. We then took a look at verses two and three concerning how life is a series of frustrations –

frustration after frustration. The first proof of frustration the Preacher points to is:

(2) Earth Remains Constant (vv. 4-7) – He provides three examples of the circular consistency of nature (sun, wind and streams/rivers).

In verse four we're told that one generation is replaced by another, and another after that, but the earth remains steady. Think about that. The significance of whatever work we are actually able to accomplish within our own generation is typically miniscule in light of the myriad generations that have come and gone. This,



I feel, is even more humbling to consider. This verse also shows us that though we can work and labor under the sun, because of our short lifespan, we get ahead only to leave this earth. This applies not only to individuals but to families, nations, kingdoms – all inhabitants of the world. We all live as contemporaries, living together in the same age, in a certain period of time, yet we all go off by death until the entire generation is consumed.

In verse five we're told that from our perspective, we see the sun rise and set, day after day. It is the same thing over and over again as the weeks, months and years continue steadily onward. For the Preacher, the sun is presented to us as a picture of the monotony of life. And not only is it monotonous, the pace is relentless: the sun has-

tens back to where it will rise again. This life we live while sojourning upon this earth seems to have become, year after year, more frenetic, more relentless, more chaotic. It never stops nor does it ever become less intense. Perhaps most of us in this congregation are retired and no longer work in a culture where year after year, more is asked, more is required, all while being made to work with less. But even in retirement, life doesn't appear to get any less hectic: there are grown kids and grandchildren with all their "drama," there are the doctors and nurses and hospitals, oh my! There's also the odd funeral and occasional wedding to attend; and time just keeps speeding up – I sometimes feel that I'm on one of those bullet speed trains and the end (of this life) is oh so near. And though we feel that our generation is experiencing the speed of life at its worst, it's obvious that nearly 3,000 years ago (the traditional conventional dates of Solomon's reign, derived from biblical chronology, is set at between 970 to 931 BC) the Preacher or Solomon felt as we feel. So the sun rises, the sun sets, and it hastens to do it all over again.

Next, the Preacher considers the wind in verse six. While the sun is fixed and goes on, the path of the wind is not static, nor does it follow (from our point of view) the same path as does the sun. It continues to blow in a circuitous fashion – around and around it goes. This truly exemplifies the rotation of men and women and things, the instability, the inconstancy, the restless state of all worldly enjoyments, the unprofitableness of our labors. We work for riches, honors, and knowledge all in service to the wind which fills our bellies with the east wind which cannot satisfy (see Ecclesiastes 5:16; Job 15:2). We, as frail humans, are like the wind that passes away and yet returns to its place while we do not.

Finally in verse seven, the Preacher considers the sea. We know that water is in constant motion - there is a loop from oceans, seas, lakes, rivers and streams to evaporation to clouds to rain and back to oceans, seas, lakes, rivers and streams. And even though streams deposit their liquid into lakes and oceans, they never fill up entirely. It's as if the work is never completed. Nature has no gain to show for its ceaseless toiling which in itself is an illustration of life's vanity and meaninglessness - its unquiet and unsettled state - the unsatisfying nature of all things. The mind of man and woman is never satisfied with any of the riches and honor he or she gains, or the knowledge they acquire. This suggests that even water, as fluctuating a body as it is, still has an advantage over mankind because the waters are always flowing, they still return to their original place - something men and women never do.

It's all a lot like several movies and television series I've seen over the years: *Star Trek IV: The Voyage Home*, *Stargate: SG1*, *Source Code*, *Looper* and *Groundhog Day*. There is a somewhat common theme of time travel and/or being stuck in a time-loop between the movies I've mentioned but I think *Groundhog Day* is particularly relevant: there is a point where the character, Phil Connors (played by Bill Murray), is talking with some friends in what sounds just like the Preacher. Phil asks, "What would you do if you were stuck in one place and every day was exactly the same and nothing that you did mattered. One of the friends, Ralph (played by Rick Overton), replies, "That about sums it up for me."

So, how is "vanity" so frustrating? Because under the sun, at least from our perspective, there is darkness and uncertainty about life. Genesis 1-11 has a significant impact upon the writer of Ecclesiastes. I believe the Preacher sees "vanity" as the result of the Fall. The hopelessness that we feel and the monotony we see is the result of our sinful disposition - we are incapable of appreciating things from God's perspective. And that leaves us frustrated and perplexed because the same God who is sovereign over creation is also sovereign

over our frustrations. He could provide the answers, and sometimes he does, but the primary focus of the Preacher is on the seasons of life that go unexplained. **PART 3 CONT'D NEXT WEEK**
